### Village Property Tax Bills Important Information

Village & Kings County tax bills are issued in May (Interim) and Sept (Final). The combined amount covers the fiscal year April 1, 2024, to March 31, 2025.

<u>Payment options</u>: Online, pre-authorized payment plan, telephone banking, at your bank or in person at the village office. For online banking – Search using <u>only</u> the word "KINGSTON". Choose KINGSTON, VILLAGE OF, NS TAXES (may vary). <u>The assessment account number (AAN) is the same for both the Village and the</u>

County of Kings so be sure to choose the correct payee's name when paying online or at the bank. (The AAN number identifies your property and cannot change).

For **Pre-Authorized Monthly or Full Amount Debit Payment Plans,** the form is available on our website or at the office. Bring/send completed form and a void cheque or banking information to Village Office.

**Cash, cheque or debit only** are accepted at the office (no credit card payments). **Mortgage paying your taxes?** Confirm with the village office that you are set up with your mortgage company. You will still receive your tax bill, please read it carefully. <u>Mailing Address Updates</u>:

### From Mid Valley Region Physician Recruitment Committee:

**Primary Care Clinic** - Short-term primary medical care for people on the Need a Family Doctor Registry list (register online or call 811). Access the Primary Care Clinic at Soldiers Memorial Hospital by appt only Mon-Fri (for residents living between Bridgetown and Aylesford) Call 902-825-5206 or 1-866-400-0060 (virtual/phone or in-office visits).

**VirtualCareNS** – Those on the Need a Family Practice Registry have free access to online and phone appts from doctors or nurse practitioners, until they can be placed with a family practice.

**Primary Care Services** - Shoppers Drug Mart Greenwood is part of the Community Pharmacy Primary Care Clinic program. Pharmacists can assess and prescribe treatment for health conditions like strip throat, eczema, diabetes, asthma and COPD. They also deal with medication management, lab tests, vaccinations and the administration of medications by injection.

**Mobile Primary Care Clinics** – for non-urgent medical care like prescription renewals and minor infections. **Free Mental Health & Addictions Services** – peer support, counselling and online, phone, or text resources.
